

Through the door of the restaurant, you enter a small room. On the right side, there is a passage. If you decide to move straight from there you will have to go down 24 stair steps. They change their direction to the left two times. After the second turn, you can see a man made of wood with no hands to your right, and you stand at the entrance to a big Room with high ceilings. You have to walk down 5 more steps to stand on the floor. Different wooden elements are embedded into the ceiling and walls, and there are several openings at the top of the Walls. Loud music is being played by two men in traditional clothes. Many wooden tables, with people that are eating or drinking beer, are spreaded in the room. If you go a few more steps inside, you can see that the room continues to your right for a few more meters and leads over to another room with less high ceilings, which can be reached by going up 3 stair steps. When you enter this space, you can see more tables on your left, a staircase leading downstairs at your right, and a kitchen behind it. If you go down the staircase, you turn right twice, and enter a long room with high ceilings and many tables, leading approximately 20 meters to the back. There is a

well at the front right side of the room. This room is on your right. If you go straight, you pass through an open door, that leads to a staircase going 13 stairsteps up. If you go up the stairs, you find yourself in another room with tables and wooden painted figures on the walls. If you go left, you pass through another open door. Behind the threshold, you can see garbage cans and empty bottles. If you go through the door and turn to your right, you can see that you are standing in a very long passage. It's very dark and you can't see it's end. When you walk along this passage, you can see several gangways that have been closed up with bricks. It's too dark to reach the end of the passage. If you turn around again, and walk back through the door you entered this passage from, you can see a closed door, which you cannot enter, at the other side of the room. If you walk to this side of the room and turn right, you can see a staircase, leading up. The staircase turns to the right two times, and while you walk up, you can notice a strong smell of cheese. At the end of the stair, you are standing in a small passage, with stairs leading up to a room on your right, and next to the stairs, an elevator. If you walk straight, you notice that you have walked a loop, as you are arriving at the kitchen again.

My thoughts were interrupted by a waiter who asked if I am looking for a table for two. It was located next to the wall and after ordering some tea, I immediately stood up to explore the space. I crossed the room and ended up in the other one that was located five steps higher the first one. I went up and turned my head right as there was dark on the left. The light was coming from the kitchen. I was looking for the toilet and my experience told me to go down the stairs that were located in front of the kitchen. As I went down turning three times right on my way. I found myself in the big room filled with light. There was an entrance to the next room and big space behind me with the large ancient well with an engraving of an angel above it. I went to it and after I turned 180 degrees just in front of me I saw a brick in the wall that seemed to fit loose comparing to the others. I went right to it and tried to take it out. To my surprise that was not hard and behind it I found about thirty letters, money and small notices dating different time. Some people were just mentioning themselves being there and

some responded to previous letters. I put the brick back and went to the next room. As I entered it on the left I saw an entrance leading outside, I was curious and entered it. There were lots of trash bins and empty bottles, so it was logical to think that there should be a way out. Although the corridor was very long. I passed about 15 metres and saw an entrance with an engraving above it that I could not see that well, the entrance was entirely blocked with stones. Then I found another one, that also was blocked. In the end of the corridor the path was turning right but it was too dark to go there. even though I think it was the way out of the cellar to the street. I turned back and after returning to the previous room in front of me I saw the stairs going up. I went there and returned to the kitchen. I made a full circle and didn't find a toilet, so I went back to my table and finished my tea.
